The 2006 season will mark the start of Scott Akasaki's seventh year with the Los Angeles Dodgers and his second season as the team's Manager of Team Travel and Traveling Secretary. Before assuming his current position, Scott spent the previous five years in the club's Asian Operations Department, most recently as the team's Manager of Japanese Affairs. At 29, he is the youngest Manager of Team Travel and Traveling Secretary in Major League Baseball. He is the first Asian American to be named to the position in Major League Baseball history. He joined the Dodgers in January 2000 after spending the previous year living in Japan, where he studied Japanese professional and amateur baseball as the recipient of the Freeman Foundation Fellowship. A *cum laude* graduate of Claremont McKenna College in 1998, he double majored in Government and Legal Studies.
